Re: Extension of school dismissal in response to Coronavirus

Dear Anaheim Elementary School District Families,

This past week we have continued to participate in daily conversations with the Orange County Department of Education and the OC Health Care Agency to receive the latest information available on the response and recommendations to the Coronavirus pandemic. The latest information we have received is that health experts are recommending weeks of social distancing to best reduce the spread of the Coronavirus.

With this in mind, and always with the best interest of the health and safety of all stakeholders, **the Anaheim Elementary School District will now remain closed through Friday, April 17, 2020**. At this time, the anticipated return date is Monday, April 20, 2020.

During the dismissal of schools, the well-being of students will continue to be our priority and we have been actively working on instructional continuity and other student needs through distance and online learning.

The following actions and resources will continue to be available for AESD students during the extended school dismissal:
