Anaheim Public Library resources

We know how important books, programs, and other resources from our partners at the Anaheim Public Library are for you, especially during these difficult times. They have adjusted their services to offer Curbside Pick-up, and virtual reading programs, storytimes, and STEAM activities through their social media accounts to better serve the community. Additionally, Anaheim Public Library staff is giving away free books, school supplies, and STEAM craft supplies at food distribution sites across the city of Anaheim.

To follow is a summary of their Continued Library Services and upcoming Summer Reading Program which can benefit your child and the entire family:

Curbside Pick-up

- Library patrons can place holds on books, DVDs, and video games through the Library catalog or over the phone for Curbside Pick-up.
- Books are available for pick-up Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Library staff will call when your books are available for pick-up. When you arrive, call the Library and your books will be safely delivered on a cart to the parking lot.
