School Reopening Communications

As a reminder, every school site will be communicating their site-specific reopening plan with both staff and families in November as follows:

- On 11/2 you should have received communication regarding the A/B cohort assignments for all general education students.
- During the week of 11/9 communication will include screening procedures, visitor policies, and safety protocols.
- During the week of 11/30 communication will include various schedules, safety information, and protocols for symptomatic students and staff.

School Reopening Advisory Committee Meeting

We will convene the School Reopening Advisory Committee on Tuesday, November 17, 2020, to review the actions that are taking place in preparation for a safe reopening. The presentations from the meeting will be shared during the November 18, 2020, Board of Education meeting and with all stakeholders on Thursday, November 19, 2020.
